Medilingua Advancing Vocational Competences in Foreign Languages for Paramedics

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Medilingua is a EU Project in the field of Transfer of Innovation in collaboration with partners from Poland, Germany, the UK, Bulgaria and Portugal. Over 200 participants attended and were introduced to the project outcomes, including the courses, podcasting technologies, the Medilingua platform, and the positive outcomes from the project's testing results.

Some of the topics covered during the event were "Using podcasting in the learning process", "The evaluation of IT incorporation and foreign language skills among paramedics in Europe", "Examples of IT tools used in learning a foreign language in medical sector", and Emergency Medical Service in Portugal and in the UK. As part of the conference several practical workshops were organized to involve participants in different aspects of the Medilingua project and courseware. All project partners took part in the conference.

Following our intensive testing phase phase and after conducting three workshops, during which we collected in-depth and constructive feedback from emergency medical services personnel, we completed and adapted the six didactic for our special English online course for rescue services personnel in late October.
